

THE GASPÉSIE TOUR

Including Montréal and Québec City, Bas-Saint-Laurent and Gaspésie

9 days, 8 nights



The **Gaspésie Tour** takes you to a vast land. A wide peninsula jutting out into the Gulf of St. Lawrence, Gaspésie is a blend of sea and mountains, from Mt. Albert and Mt. Jacques-Cartier to the cliffs of Forillon and from the rural charm of the Chaleur Bay region to the turbulent rivers running through the valleys and the savage beauty of Haute-Gaspésie.

Visit the many towns and villages scattered throughout this territory and get acquainted with its cheerful and friendly inhabitants.

DAY 1

Arrival in Montréal, rest, dinner and overnight stay

DAY 2 – Montréal – Québec (253 km)

Visit of Montréal and lunch

Dinner and overnight stay in Québec City

DAY 3 – Québec – Matane (410 km)

AM

Visit of the [Pointe-au-Père Maritime Historic Site](#) (320 km). Duration: 3 h, including a tour of the *Onondaga* submarine

Lunch in the Rimouski sector

Alternatives

① Located 35 km south of Rimouski, the [Canyon des Portes de l'Enfer](#) ("hell's gate canyon") offers hiking trails; the highest suspension bridge in Québec; and the "descent into hell," a 300-step staircase that takes you down to the

Rimouski River. The site also pays tribute to the timber drivers of old.

Duration: 1 h to 3 h, depending on the activity

② *Fly from Mont-Joli to Anticosti!*

PM

Visit of the [Reford Gardens](#) and the [International Garden Festival](#) in Grand-Métis (40 km) or the [Matane Salmon Observation Centre](#) in Matane (95 km)

Duration: 3 h

Dinner and overnight stay in the Matane sector

Alternative

Enjoy a unique adventure and soak up spectacular scenery at the [Chic-Chocs Mountain Lodge](#).

Departure from Cap-Chat (daily shuttle on weekdays)

Duration: 1 to 3 days

DAY 4 – Matane – Gaspé via Gaspésie National Park (410 km)

AM

Visit of the highest vertical-axis wind turbine in the world at [Éole Cap-Chat](#). Duration: 1 h 30

Visit of [Exploramer](#) and sea excursion. Duration: 3 h

Lunch in the Sainte-Anne-des-Monts sector or at the [Gîte du Mont-Albert](#) hotel

PM

Visit of [Gaspésie National Park](#) (130 km). Hike to Lac-aux-Américains or along part of the [International Appalachian Trail](#)

Dinner and overnight stay in the Gaspé sector (280 km)

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DAY 5 – Gaspé – Percé (85 km)

AM

Visit of [Manoir Le Boutillier](#) (30 km via route 197)
Duration: 1 h

Visit of the [Forillon National Park of Canada](#)
interpretation centre (10 km). Duration: 1 h

Picnic lunch in the Cap-Bon-Ami sector

PM

Visit of the Grande-Grave sector in [Forillon National Park of Canada](#) (20 km). Duration: 1 h

Whale-watching excursion with [Croisières Baie-de-Gaspé](#). Departure from the Grande-Grave wharf
Duration: 3 h

Dinner and overnight stay in the Percé sector (125 km)

Alternatives

① Enjoy a round of 18-hole golf at the [Auberge Fort-Prével](#) golf club in Saint-Georges-de-Malbaie
Duration: 4 h or 5 h

② Fly from Gaspé to spend a few enchanting days in the [Îles de la Madeleine!](#)

③ Board the [M/V CTMA Vacancier](#) for a cruise on the St. Lawrence to the Îles de la Madeleine. Departures every Saturday. Return cruise to Chandler and Montréal on Tuesdays.

DAY 6 – Percé – Bonaventure (130 km)

AM

Visit of [Bonaventure Island and Percé Rock National Park](#). Excursion to Bonaventure Island with [Croisières Julien-Cloutier](#) or [Bateliers de Percé](#). Duration: 4 h

Picnic lunch on the island

PM

Visit of [Magasin général historique authentique 1928](#) (a former general store) in L'Anse-à-Beaufils (11 km)
Duration: 1 h 30

Visit of the [Banc-de-Pêche-de-Paspébiac Historic Site](#) (105 km). Duration: 1 h 30

Visit of the [Bioparc de la Gaspésie](#) in Bonaventure (25 km). Duration: 1 h 30

Activities with [Cime Aventures](#) in Bonaventure (130 km)

Dinner and overnight stay in the Bonaventure sector

DAY 7 – Bonaventure – Rimouski (330 km)

AM

Visit of the [Gaspesian British Heritage Village](#) in New Richmond (30 km). Duration: 1 h

Lunch in the Carleton sector (30 km)

PM

Fishing excursion with [Excursion L'Omirlou](#) in Carleton.
Duration: 2 h 30

Visit of [Miguasha National Park](#), a UNESCO World Heritage Site (30 km). Duration: 1 h 30

Dinner and overnight stay in the Causapschal sector (110 km) or the Rimouski sector (240 km)

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DAY 7 (cont'd)

Alternative

Discover the thrill of the aerial trails in the "[Forêt de Maître Corbeau](#)" park in the heart of a unique old-growth forest in Saint-Gabriel de Rimouski

Duration: 3 h to 4 h

DAY 8 – Rimouski – Québec (312 km)

AM

Visit of [Bic National Park](#) (20 km). Duration: 2 h

Lunch in the Rivière-du-Loup sector (95 km)

PM

Dinner and overnight stay in Québec City (206 km) or at the [Maisons du Phare de l'Île Verte](#) B&B. Ferry crossing from the municipality of Isle Verte.

Duration: 1 h 30

Alternatives

① Discover the islands and lighthouses of the St. Lawrence during a sea excursion with [Société Duvetnor](#).

Duration: 1 h 30 to 3 h

② Spend several hours in the charming village of Kamouraska. While you are there, visit the [SEBKA](#) to go kayaking or rock climbing.

Duration: 3 h to 6 h

③ Relax and have fun at the [Pohénégamook Santé Plein Air](#) resort centre. Take your pick from canoeing, kayaking, hiking and spa. Duration: 2 h or full day, depending on the activity. Lodging also available on site.

④ Savour regional flavours during a visit to [Domaine Acer](#), a maple ecomuseum. Duration: 1 h 30
